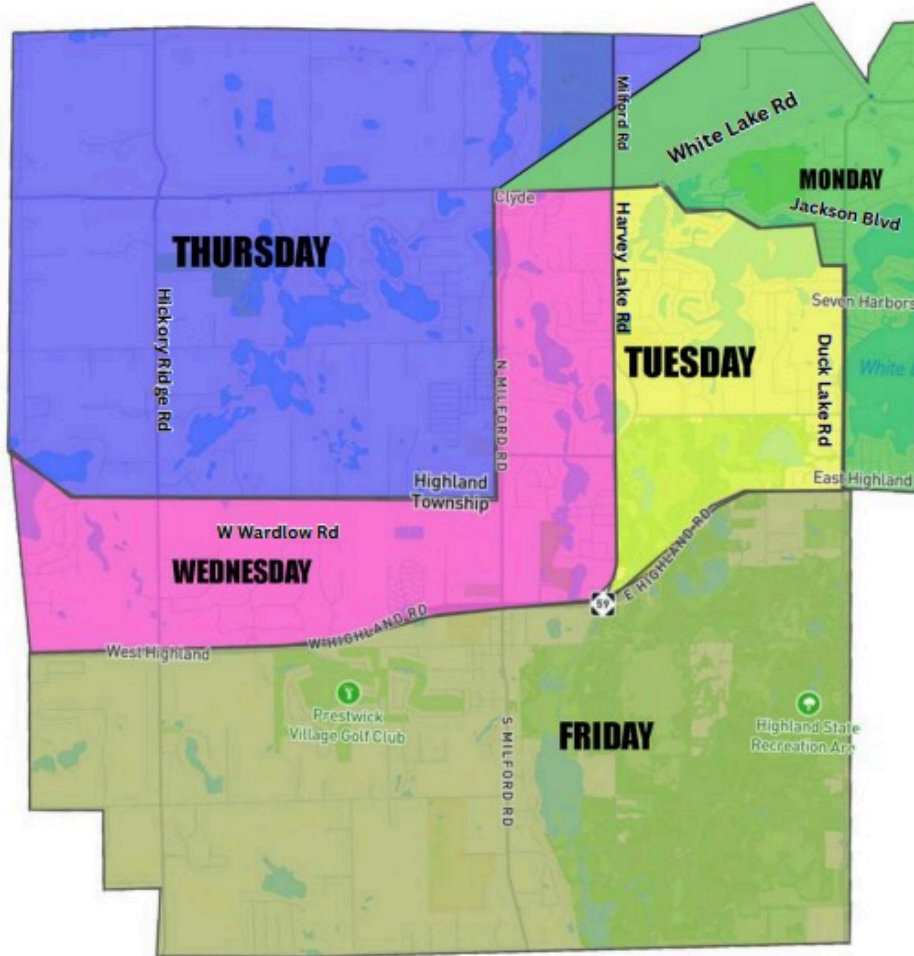

THANK YOU, Highland residents, for your summer tax payments! Highland Township had an amazing 95% collection rate this summer.

If you have not yet paid your 2024 Summer Taxes, they are still payable to "Highland Township" at our township hall in person, put in one of our drop boxes or online at <https://www.oakgov.com/government/pay-taxes> There is a 1% penalty added monthly through February 14, 2025, call us if you would like an updated amount owed.

Winter 2024 tax bills will be mailed out December 1st and are due February 14, 2025.

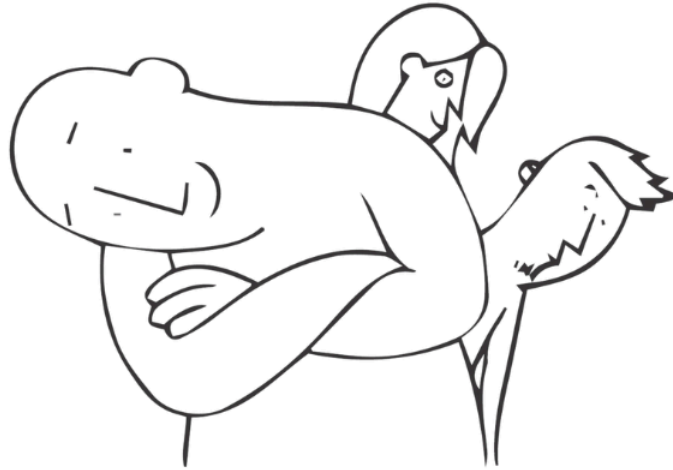

**OAK HILL CEMETERY**  
On June 1, 1822, the Pontiac Company gave the citizens of Pontiac the first land for a village cemetery. It was "to be occupied and used forever as a burying ground." In 1839, when Captain Hervey Parke was employed by the village to survey Outlot 9 of the original plat of the village, Oak Hill Cemetery was laid out. Many of the early pioneers who had been buried near the intersection of Saginaw and Huron streets and on private property were reinterred here after 1839. The cemetery contains the Buckland Memorial Chapel, built of Berea sandstone in 1898 by Don Carlos Buckland. Among the monuments of note are those of Major General Israel B. Richardson, Governor Moses Wisner and David Ward. Acreage across Mt. Clemon (renamed University) and Paddock streets was added to the original site as for increased space arose

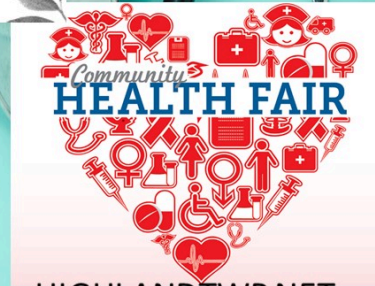
